pop culture subversion, or the unpredictability of mixed media experimentation, the collective continues to evolve, disrupt, and redefine itself.

Ry Shorosky's work between the road and the lens, shaped by years spent driving long-haul routes across the U.S. and

documenting the people and places he encountered along the way. His creative practice reflects a deep respect for the working class and the rhythms of everyday life. With a focus on presence,



place, and the human spirit, his photography and films aim to bridge distances—both geographic and personal—through honest storytelling.





Nico French painter Roussin is a based in Las Vegas whose work explores the interplay between light, texture, and depth. Working primarily in black and white, he creates dynamic compositions that shift with perception, capturing the nature of illumination and shadow. Using brushes as his primary tool, Roussin builds layered surfaces that evolve with changes in lighting and perspective, allowing his paintings to take on a sculptural quality. His monochromatic approach emphasizes contrast, revealing intricate textures and movements that challenge the viewer's sense of space and dimension.
